MO'S TERESA settled off the leaders and slightly off the fence, came out some and made steady progress on backstretch, engaged leaders three wide into second turn, battled outside pacesetter, gained advantage passing sixteenth marker, edged away and safely held. CANALASSO broke alertly then settled off the pace, secured the inside, stalked from along the rail, moved up on the second turn, waited for room approaching the stretch, shifted out in the drive and finished strongly from outside winner. CLOCKERSCORNERROSY unhurried in early stages while dropping well back, saved ground into the stretch, came out slightly, rallied and gained the show. MUNA JEWELS quickly assumed command, dictated the pace from the inside, resisted when challenged leaving the backstretch, battled along the rail well into the stretch but yielded in final sixteenth. LIL BARBIE DOODLE pressured the pacesetter from off the rail, moved up and bid between rivals nearing quarter marker, dropped back some, came three wide into the stretch and weakened. STAR OF THE NIGHT broke in slightly then drifted out into first turn, remained well off the fence then three wide to the lane and weakened. JAZZ GIRL chased three wide into initial turn, remained well off the fence then outside rival past quarter marker, continued three wide and was outrun.
