Footnotes

LORD ELIJAH never far back, rallied five wide through the final turn and dug in to be up in time. ROCKINSTOMPER was slow to find his stride, worked forward through the backstretch and was closing the fastest but ran out of ground. STRENGTH chased the leaders from the start, attempted to rally just off the rail when turning for home, was blocked, shifted in, blocked again, accelerated when a hole opened off the rail and gamely split those rivals to get up in time for the show. EL GATO FAMOSO rushed up to duel with FUTURE SEARCH for a half mile, assumed a short lead, then weakened in the drive. WARREN ROAD was always close, came three wide through the final turn and closed evenly. FOR DADDY raced in the middle of the pack and did not reach contention. FUTURE SEARCH set a pressured pace for a half mile and gave out. PRINCE CARSON showed little. PERSIAN REVENGE was not a factor. MARACHO had no speed.
