**Footnotes**

CASA O unhurried early from bit off the rail, made steady progress four wide on final backstretch, swept past leader entering the stretch and powered away. ANGA angled over early, chased along the rail then two wide, came out in the stretch and picked up the place. KIM'S LEADING MAN chased from the inside, moved up strongly through stretch first time, bid alongside leader, dueled into final backstretch, pulled cleared into final turn but was overtaken into the lane then lost second. CAPTAIN BEAU was bumped in opening strides, raced two wide and off the rail throughout then weakened. COOKIN EXPRESSO stepped to the front, set pace to second turn, dueled inside rival into final backstretch, dropped back and faded. BATTLE POINT was forced in and bumped shortly after the start, chased off the rail then four wide and lacked any response. LUCKY B LOU stalked from along the rail through two turns, dropped back and also weakened. PADRE JON stalked from off the rail, continued three then four wide through two turns then dropped back and gave way.

A CHANCE TO RACE forced the early pace, lost contact around the second turn then was pulled up on the final turn and walked off.
