### Footnotes

STUDIO CITY broke very alertly, set pressured pace from along the rail, roused exiting the turn, kicked clear and maintained safe cushion late under urging. BULLETTGIRL angled over the pressured the pacesetter into and around the turn, lost contact in upper stretch and gamely lasted for second. WILD HICKORY tracked the pace while outside rival, continued on same path around the turn, came out bit in the drive, closed strongly and just missed second. TERRELLA stalked from the inside, saved ground into the stretch, angled out some in the lane but was no late threat. GREGARIOUS GAL broke in and bumped rival, quickly secured the rail, remained inside throughout and never menaced. RED LASER GAL reserved along the rail, chased just off the fence leaving the turn and lacked needed response. PLEASE PAY was bumped at the start and slow into stride, taken off the rail early, trailed two wide around the turn and was outrun.
