Footnotes

AXTEC angled in approaching the first turn, came out near the second turn and three deep into the stretch, waited a bit then gamely split foes in the lane to gain the lead and pulled clear. MOST OF ALL, in tight into the first turn, saved ground, steadied off heels into the second turn, came out four wide into the stretch and finished well for second. CARR DE MON stalked the pace a bit off the rail, bid three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and just held third. NATIVE GOLD DIGGER saved ground unhurried early, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch with a late bid. SECURITIZED DEBT angled in and dueled outside KNIFE FORK SWOON, battled between rivals on the second turn and weakened late. WHITTLE angled in on the first turn and saved ground, waited off heels into the stretch then was boxed in between and behind rivals in the lane. DIXIE LOE saved ground, moved up on the second turn but steadied in tight, then was blocked along the rail in the stretch. KNIFE FORK SWOON dueled inside, fought back in the stretch but weakened late. BLACK DIAMOND LTD. settled outside, dropped back, lugged out on the second turn and weakened. ESCONCE pulled early, raced close up outside to the second turn and weakened. The stewards conducted an inquiry into incidents entering each turn involving the top two finishers but made no change when they ruled the incidents minor.
