ATTICUS JACK was sent to front into initial bend, rated from along the rail, padded cushion on the final backstretch, had that lead shrink on the last turn but determinedly held under strong handling. NORVSKY angled in and stalked pace, bided time on same path, launched rally nearing last bend, came three wide into the stretch, fought outside EL GATO MALO in upper stretch, then disposed of that rival and closed gap late on the winner. EL GATO MALO prominently placed early, tracked pacesetter while outside foe, lost contact with leader on the final backstretch, whittled that gap some on the last turn, battled inside runner-up in upper stretch but lacked needed late punch. QUINDICI MAN reserved from along the fence, chased inside around two turns, angled out, came three wide into the stretch and went willingly to wire. ACHAK (IRE) gained stalking position from off the rail, continued on three wide path, dropped back and lacked any late response. PODE IR (BRZ) taken off the pacesetter into first turn, tracked pace from along the rail, dropped back leaving second turn and also weakened. CHOCOLATE CANDY outside foe early, continued bit off the rail chasing pace, angled out some leaving second turn but lacked any late response.
