Footnotes

RACKETEER content to settle while two wide then between horses, made steady progress three wide into and around the final turn, whittled gap on leader, led past sixteenth marker and edged away under vigorous handling. MAN CHESTER MAN stalked either three wide or between horses, moved up nearing last turn, bid three deep into that bend, gained lead then edged away, came in some but was overtaken a sixteenth out. THE HUNT IS ON unhurried while slightly off the fence, chased two wide through two turns, shifted out and caught four wide on the last turn, came back in and rallied to gain third. PREFERRED BEHAVIOR reserved from off the rail, chased four wide then engaged leaders three wide, battled outside rival on the final backstretch, gained brief lead on that bend, relinquished control and weakened some. ST PATRICKS APPEAL set or forced the early issue from bit off the fence, battled inside rival on the final backstretch, lost contact around the last turn and faded. LOW GEAR POWER reserved from off the rail, caught three wide around the middle turn then four wide entering the stretch and never threatened. CAPE TRUTH close up early from the inside, tracked the leaders from along the rail for more than half-mile, came off the fence but never threatened. UP COUNTRY reserved along the rail, later came out and caught five wide exiting the final turn while outrun. WHO'S YOUR NEXT EX rated along the rail, forced the pace from the inside to second turn, dropped back departing that bend and gave way.
