QUINDICI MAN angled in early and chased along the rail to the final turn, shifted out, rallied four wide into the stretch then reeled in leader under vigorous handling and inched away late from well off the rail. ALL SAINT secured the rail and stalked inside around two turns, was steered out passing three-eighths marker, made headway three wide around final turn, reached the front passing eighth marker, edged away but could not stave off winner. SINGER ISLAND squeezed some at the start, settled in stalking position while off the rail, remained three wide, moved up, bid then gained brief lead approaching the stretch, could not match top pair in the drive but held gamely for third. PREMIERE FLYER unhurried while outside foe, angled out some, came three then four wide into the stretch and gained minor award. ACTION IN MAY was forced in bit at the break, settled along the fence, hugged the rail into final turn, angled out then rallied strongly from between foes in the lane. DEL CONTE broke inward, was sent to the front then content to prompted the issue into final backstretch, remained prominent inside into the lane then weakened. DOVER STREET ART (IRE) was three wide early then chased from between foes, dropped back and weakened. FARADAY pulling early and gained control with lap left, set the pace until nearing the final bend, relinquished control and gave way readily. JAZZANDTHEMAGICIAN came off the rail early, chased three wide, caught three deep into second turn, remained off the rail and weakened.
