GETSETGETREADYGO bobbled slightly while still breaking alertly, quickly sped to uncontested lead, extended that margin while slightly off the rail and was kept to task late. MI ALMA tracked leader from the inside, came two wide into the stretch and edged away late for the place. FREEDOM GENERAL angled in some and prominently placed early, stalked three wide around the turn and into the lane and could not match inside rival for second. SI ES VERDAD chased from the inside, saved ground throughout and went evenly to the wire. BRITE EYED N LUCKY bumped by outside rival leaving the gate then steadied off same foe's heels shortly after the start, chased four then three wide to the stretch and was no factor. SKID settled inside, raced slightly off the rail, remained on two wide path and lacked needed response. EXPRESS TRAIN outrun early, chased either two wide or along the rail and never threatened. WARRENS LUCKYSTORM broke in some and bumped rival then came back over leaving the chute, chased four wide, remained well off the rail and weakened.
