**Footnotes**

CAYAMBE stepped to front into first turn, rated from slightly off the rail, roused on last turn to retain cushion, continued two wide into the lane, dug in stubbornly in prolonged drive and held sway from between rivals under strong urging. QUINDICI MAN content to lag back while shifting over, chased inside into final backstretch, came out, moved up between foes then rapidly advanced inside on the final turn, loomed along the rail, inched closer in final sixteenth but was denied in game effort. RED DOOR DRIVE taken off the pacesetter and content to track that rival from off the rail, continued three wide into last bend, roused around that bend, continued outside winner into the lane, battled three wide in drive but was turned back while three deep on the wire. SPURRIER was bit squeezed and bobbed in opening strides, lagged back inside, trailed along rail into final backstretch, came out bit, advanced two wide and chased top trio home while best of rest. CIGAR MAN reserved off pace, chased two wide then outside foe, angled out, moved up, caught five wide into final bend then four wide around that turn, came three wide into the stretch and failed to sustain rally late. BOOYAH settled between rivals, chased bit off the fence, later raced three then four wide into the stretch while never menacing. UNUSUAL SMOKE gained the rail early, stalked from the inside into final backstretch, dropped back some, came off the fence and never threatened. ALL SAINT gained stalking position outside winner, tracked that foe two wide, dropped back nearing last turn, then weakened inside. TRES BORRACHOS stumbled leaving the gate, settled off the rail, chased three wide, came out nearing last turn, caught four then five wide and lacked any late response. SWIFT WINDS gained forwardly position while bit off the rail, stalked either outside foe or two wide, dropped back around last bend and faded. HEY ELVIS (AUS) bobbed leaving the gate, settled outside, then three wide, veered out into second turn, dropped back rapidly, then was pulled up when he bled through the nostrils and was vanned off.
