Footnotes

A PINT FOR MARY stalked leaders while outside foe to the turn, chased three wide around the bend, came in bit in upper stretch, straightened then rallied strongly and collared leader late. LEFT TURN ONLY tracked leaders early then bid three deep into turn, battled outside rival around the turn, gained slim advantage, edged away but was overtaken nearing wire. ZILARATOR bobbled slightly leaving the gate, angled in gradually, inside winner leaving backstretch, chased inside then came out some and went willingly to the wire. RAGE ON unhurried while shifting to the inside, chased along the rail, came back out then finished with interest on four wide path. CHURCHONSUNDAY contested the early pace inside then battled inside runner-up around the turn but weakened inside in the drive. HAPPY HEDGER dueled early outside rival then between horses to the turn, steadied past the quarter marker and dropped back, continued off the rail, steadied again inside eighth marker and weakened. MR. NIGHT RIDER dwelt at the start, lagged far back early and trailed throughout.
