Z HUMOR quickly sent to the lead, rated from along the rail, moved away bit leaving second turn, under strong asking on final turn and when challenged into the stretch then determinedly held under vigorous handling. ACCLAMATION settled inside then bit off the rail while stalking the pacesetter, moved up into final bend, loomed outside winner entering the stretch, battled gamely in the drive but got no closer in the lane. RACKETEER settled inside, saved ground chasing the pace to the final turn, angled out some, between foes in the drive and pulled away late to best others. TREVOR'S CLEVER lagged back from the inside, saved ground around two turns, shifted out, caught three wide into and around the final turn and failed to threaten. QUARTER MOON caught three wide early, chased on same path into the stretch and lacked needed late response. OVERBID settled from between foes, chased outside runner-up in the early stages, later secured the rail, remained inside and weakened. NO DREAM three wide on the first turn, moved up to pressure the pacesetter then settled off the leader, dropped back nearing final bend and faded. CIGAR MAN reserved while bit off the rail, chased two then three wide, also lost contact and gave way.
