Footnotes

ASHLEY'S GAMBLE tucked in behind the pacesetter into backstretch stalked to second turn, shifted out three wide into the lane, rallied, reached the front nearing sixteenth marker, bumped by runner-up late and gamely lasted. MICHAILASHEARTLITE reserved three wide, chased from off the rail, roused and advanced four wide around last turn and into the lane, came in bit in the drive, bumped with winner late and missed. LUCKY SIS three wide then outside foe early, chased from off the rail, also came four wide into the stretch, rallied and gained the show. SPARK CITY sped to the front and crossed over, set the pace from the inside, retained cushion into the lane, was overtaken nearing sixteenth marker and yielded late. ALASKA MISS drifted out into first turn, settled three wide, angled to the rail later on the backstretch, continued inside and lacked needed response. MISSILETTE outside foe early, moved up from off the rail then three wide into second turn between horses later on that bend, steadied sharply entering the stretch and weakened. MISS NIKKI C. was fractious in the gate and bit tight leaving the gate, chased inside and never menaced. LESLIE RULES forced the early issue, stalked from off the rail, dropped back and weakened. The steward conducted an inquiry involving the incident nearing the wire but ruled that MICHAILASHEARTLITE was at fault for coming over and causing the bumping.
