**Footnotes**

HUMDINGER saved ground early while racing in the middle of the pack, steadily advanced to gain a short lead five fences out, drew clear into the stretch and increased his advantage under steady urging. SCAVENGER was unhurried early, steadily advanced after the first circuit, finished well but couldn't threaten the winner. GREAT GUSTO was unhurried early, rallied after eight fences and finished well without threatening. ICE IS NICE set the early pace under pressure, stalked the leaders to the final uphill and weakened. DEJAVUALLOVERAGAIN saved ground in the middle of the pack, made a brief bid after the eighth fence and gave way. FANTORINI raced in the middle of the pack and had no rally. LIGHT SPEED dueled for the lead on the outside through nine fences and tired. MESHWAAR dueled for the lead between horses early, held a brief lead to near the eighth fence and gave way. GLIDE KING dueled early on the inside, dropped back after the first fence, raced in the middle of the pack and lacked a rally. PLANETS ALIGNED raced wide in the middle of the pack, rallied briefly after five fences but was soon through. ENDLESS MOUNTAIN trailed. CUSE was rank before the start, broke with the field but was pulled up after the first fence after his saddle slipped.
