CLASS INDIAN rated in the middle of the pack early, was content to trail through the ninth jump, put in a strong rally up the far-turn hill to gain command near the last jump and prevailed under strong urging. CORNHUSKER (GB) rated through the first circuit, steadily advanced to gain command after the third-last jump, dueled over the last two jumps and battled gamely to the end. DUC DE SAVOIE took command near the third jump to hold a clear lead through the first circuit, drew off to a long lead, still held a commanding lead three jumps out and stopped suddenly. OLD TIMER raced on the outside and had no rally. BEST ALIBI (IRE) was rank early when taken in hand, settled down to rate in the middle of the pack and was pulled up before the third-last jump. LETTER PERFECT quickly took command, relinquished his lead halfway through the first circuit, remained competitively through nine jumps and was then pulled up. PER RULING DATED MAY11, 2012 RECEIVED FROM THE NATIONAL STEEPLECHASE ASSOCIATION, CLASS INDIAN WAS DQ'D DUE TO A POSITIVE TEST.
