Footnotes

DEMONSTRATIVE rated, rallied on the inside after the fourth-last fence, rallied between horses brushing with PTARMIGAN, challenged at the last fence and drew away. BALLETT BOY (IRE) stalked the pace, gained command before third-last fence, drew off to a clear lead and tired in the stretch. GRANTOR started well, dropped to the rear of the pack, steadily advanced to loom boldly on the outside three fences out and failed to sustain his bid. GREEN VELVET set a pressured pace and weakened after the third-last fence. STRAIGHT TO IT raced in the middle of the pack and lacked a rally. PENSY was outrun throughout. FARAH T SALUTE rated in the middle of the pack, advanced in the middle of the race and was done before the third-last fence. EAMONN trailed. PTARMIGAN pressed the pace, had a short lead, ran prominently to the second-last fence, brushed with the winner, tired, then stumbled on the last fence. TWISTER CROSSING pressed the pace, steadily weakened, then pulled up after the third fence.
