FIVE PINES stalked the pace, gained command after the fifth fence, set a pressured pace and prevailed under a long drive. DANCE FASTER was well placed, challenged the winner three fences out and finished well. BE GREAT, never far back, rallied into the stretch, then failed to sustain his bid. NEW MAMBO quickly took command, pressed the pace to the final fence and weakened. DIAMOND FEVER was outrun on the outside. EMBARRASSED was outrun. BEER FRAME ran in the middle of the pack and tired. DUCK HUNT was outrun and pulled up before the last fence. DISTANT STRIKE was outrun and pulled up at the second-last fence. COLONIAL KID stalked the pace to the ninth fence and then was pulled up before the third-last fence.
