Footnotes

PALS PRIDE set a pressured pace, stumbled at the second-last fence and prevailed in a long drive. HUMDINGER stalked the early pace, steadily dropped back on the first circuit while saving ground, rallied after the seventh fence to make a bid entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. ONE SEA was blocked at the start, raced early in the middle of the pack, rallied after the seventh fence, bid for command at the tenth fence and then finished evenly. EAGLE BEAGLE was unhurried early while trailing, was in tight along the inside after the seventh fence, moved quickly to loom boldly a furlong out and then hung. SWIMMING RIVER was blocked at the start, trailed early, advanced after six fences, remained well placed to the stretch and gave way. PONCE (NZ) pressed the pace through ten fences and gave way. WHAT A PRIZE (NZ) stalked the pace to the tenth fence and gave way. BETHPAGE BLACK was outrun early, trailed and was pulled up before the eleventh fence. IN PURSUIT OF LOVE moved out of post position order just before the start, wheeled at the start blocking two rivals, raced in the middle of the pack, tired and pulled up before the eleventh fence.
