HARRY'S FIREBOLT stalked the pace on the outside, bid for command at the fourth fence, continued pressing the pace through nine fences, took command before the tenth fence and prevailed in a long drive. CHANGE COURSE stalked the early pace, gained command between horses at the fourth fence, led to the tenth fence and continued only gamely. CLASSY BRUTE set a pressured pace through four fences, pressed the pace to the ninth fence and weakened. SPY IN THE SKY stumbled at the first fence and unseated his rider.
