Footnotes

WE WANTED IT MORE was allowed to settle for a half, bid three wide into the second turn, was forced to circle six wide into the stretch then found his best stride in mid stretch and drove to the front late. PENNY'S IMAGE was unhurried to the half, bid two on the second turn, eased out four deep into the stretch then was behind a wall of horses but waited patiently, found room and split foes leaving mid stretch and surged late. SUNDAY COMIC was under pressure early to establish position close to the pace, stalked to the second turn, bid three wide to the stretch, dueled in mid stretch then stayed on late while being outkicked. FROM HERE TO THERE never far back for a half, saved ground on the second turn, was among the leaders in mid stretch then was also outfinished but stayed gamely. BEST LAID PLANS prompted the pace to the second turn, bid two wide to the stretch, joined the leaders nearing mid stretch but could not sustain the needed bid and weakened. PAT'S PARADISE stalked the pace to the second turn, came two wide and rallied to also duel in upper stretch but tired in the final sixteenth. REDVETTE was unhurried for a half, bid three wide into the second turn then eased out and followed the winner six wide into the stretch but could not muster a closing response. LA MIDNITE SPECIAL set the pace for six furlongs, responded to pressure to mid stretch then gave way. LAND ROCKET had no speed, was two wide throughout and never threatened. VOLACIOUS chased the pace for a half mile then dropped back on the second turn and stopped in the drive.
