ISADAIYSBELLE broke cleanly but slipped back and raced under patient handling to the second turn, swung five wide to circle the leaders into the stretch, rallied steadily and was up late to win driving. PAWN SHOP raced unhurried early three wide, offered her bid four wide on the second turn, challenged for the lead in mid stretch but could not hold the winner. EGYPTIAN FEMME set the early pace from just off the rail, was head on the backstretch while dropping to the rail but continued to track into the stretch and raced gamely through the drive. LUCKY AT MIDNIGHT was void of speed to the stretch then finished with good speed. DAITANNA stalked the pace three wide, took command in the upper stretch but slackened late. PENNGROVE stalked early from the rail, took command two wide nearing the half, maintained an advantage into the stretch then gave way from the inside. NEW HAVEN LINE settled early, raced three wide throughout but lacked a closing response.
