**Footnotes**

HE'S A SURE CALL chased the leaders to the turn, circled four wide when set down at the five sixteenths, rallied to engage the leaders to mid stretch then dug in late to inch clear. T. D.'S GOLD stalked the pace to the turn, came two wide to the stretch, had to await room briefly in upper stretch but got past MOUNTAIN YODELER, rallied once clear, had a short lead to deep stretch but could not hold off the winner. EIGHT STITCHES broke alertly then was outsprinted to the turn, bid three wide to the stretch, was among the leader to mid stretch then was outfinished. JETS TO BRAZIL stalked the pace to the turn, bid two wide to the stretch, took the lead to mid stretch then was also outfinished. KNOWN ASSOCIATE had no speed and saved ground to the stretch but lacked the needed response. FAR ROCKAWAY was outsprinted to the turn, raced three wide to the stretch, eased out for room but came up empty in the drive. MOUNTAIN YODLER was hustled to the front, set the pace to mid turn, met a bid to the stretch but was tiring in the final furlong.
