SANICH LADY checked slightly in the chute off of SASSIE JO LASSIE's heels, tracked the leaders to the turn, rallied three wide and drew alongside the pacesetters into the stretch, edged clear to mid stretch then responded gamely to strong urging to hold. GALLANT LOVE hopped at the start but recovered quickly and attended the pace outside SASSIE JO LASSIE to the turn, responded to pressure into the stretch, fell away from the winner to mid stretch but fought back gamely under vigorous handling to just miss. ICE BOX RAIDER was allowed to settle to the turn then gradually closed the gap in the drive while not a threat. SUMMER STRAW broke a step slow and was outrun. SASSIE JO LASSIE broke alertly but lugged inward in the chute, straightened and dueled for the lead to the quarter pole then stopped in the drive.
