### Footnotes

SHEM was well placed behind the leader to the second turn, rallied two wide and drew alongside to the quarter pole, inched to a short lead to mid stretch then dug in determinedly under steady handling to hold. RUN IT was allowed to settle to the half, had to wait for room behind STORMY SURGE on the second turn, had room once straightened for the drive and rallied willingly but missed. SIR AL (IRE) bobbled a bit at the start, stalked the pace to the second turn, came three wide to the stretch and finished well but was too late. LOCKFORD had no speed, commenced a bid nearing the three eighths, was under urging while four wide on the second turn then also closed ground late. STORMY SURGE set the pace for five furlongs, was overcome by the winner on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. COVER MAGIC tracked the pace to the second turn, tried to rally three wide to the stretch but came up empty in the drive.
