HIGHLY DECORATED was not asked for speed early and raced unhurried to the turn, was forced to rally five wide into the lane but responded with a smart rally to take command just inside the furlong pole and drew clear impressively. LUTALO dueled two wide into the stretch, could not go with the winner but held well for second. BIG BAD JIM raced well placed from the rail to the turn, eased out to be four wide and just inside the winner into the stretch and finished steadily although no match for that rival. MAGIC OF THE MOON lacked good early speed, rallied from just off the rail into the stretch then flattened out. STEPPINGIN THE LIGHT set the pace from the inside to the upper stretch and weakened. CAMMY THE JET broke slow then saved ground to no avail. A. J. DA SKIPPER took back from between the leaders in the opening stages and stalked to the stretch then did not respond. STICK EM UP broke alertly but fell back quickly, raced three wide into the stretch and did not rally. DIXICO raced wide throughout and had no late response. EXCESS OF CLASS checked back nearing the half mile pole off heels then saved ground on the turn and did not respond. PICO PETE was well placed outside, had a brief bid three wide on the turn and stopped.
