CLEVER DORCAS pressured EMMA G to the far turn, responded and drew even into the stretch, got her head in front at the furlong marker, was passed in deep stretch but fought gamely late and just got the nod. EMMA G set the pace to the half, met the winner's bid on the second turn, dueled in a long drive while alternating on the lead to deep stretch but was nodded on the line. VICTORIA'S GARDEN raced three wide to the backstretch, settled into a comfortable position to the half, saved ground to the stretch but was a non-threatening third. DASH N ASH had no speed, advanced three deep to the stretch then flattened out in the drive. POLY OLE tracked the leaders to the far turn but lacked a closing response. ITALIAN WINE saved ground to no avail. MIZZ CHARLEE raced four wide to the backstretch and did not threaten. LYDIASWILD was always outrun.
