CAJUN MARKET pushed to duel for the lead early, was off the rail on the turn, responded when set down in mid stretch and held gamely. ELINDA was loose prior to the start but did not get too far from the gate then was a bit reluctant to load, had no speed, saved ground to the stretch then finished gamely inside to the wire. INTRIGUING tracked the pace to the turn, saved ground to the stretch then also was gaining ground late. HERE BE DRAGONS attended the pace outside the winner, was three wide to the stretch, battled to deep stretch then was outfinished. HERE IT TIZ was outsprinted early, got fanned four wide while being roused to the stretch, eased out widest in the drive and also was gaining late. STORMY SIERRA stalked the pace to the turn, was between rivals two wide to the stretch then finished steadily. BE THERE FOR ME tracked the pace to the turn, came three wide to the stretch but could not threaten in the late stages.
