Footnotes

LUCKY TO STAY HOME broke a bit slow and was hurried to join the pace early, dueled from the rail to the stretch, pushed clear to mid stretch then was under steady urging to the line. PERFECT NODOUBLE had no speed and trailed to the turn, was roused at the three eighths, rallied along the rail and closed the gap with a stout run to mid stretch but lost her punch while second best. HOW NOW chased the pace to the turn, was caught out four wide to the stretch but rallied to mid stretch then tired through the final furlong. CORRINAS SEEKER contested the pace while widest of three rivals, remained three deep to the stretch while being outkicked and faded in the drive. CANALASSO stalked the leaders to the turn, was asked three wide but came up empty in the stretch then pulled up following the finish and was vanned off. ANNIE'S JOURNEY chased the leaders two wide to the stretch but weakened through the lane. ELLE WOODS was hustled to duel for the lead between rivals to the quarter pole, stopped in the stretch, was eased but walked off.
