HAVANNA JACK broke slow and was permitted to settle into stride, commenced his bid once on the turn, angled three wide to rally into the stretch, collared CUVEE CITY in mid stretch and won going away driving . CUVEE CITY prompted the pace two wide to the stretch, forged to the front and drew clear at the furlong pole but proved no match for the winner . BARTOK'S PRIDE tracked the pace from the inside to the furlong pole then lacked the needed response . JORDAN RIVER raced unhurried early, saved ground to the stretch and came on without being a serious factor . STREET CONSENSUS broke alertly, fell back, raced four wide on the turn and failed to offer a bid. TANNER'S EVENT stalked the pace two wide and between horses to mid turn then came up empty . MANGO CHUTNEY sprinted clear in the opening stages but had little left once in the stretch . C WILLY STREAKING was well placed but gave out while three wide on the turn .
