Footnotes

SLYCY broke alertly and dueled early from the rail, edged clear on the turn and into the stretch but was fully extended to last. BLUE LINE CAT was well placed early, advanced inside to the stretch, shifted out for the drive and finished steadily. EVAN ALRIGHTY was void of early speed, got fanned five wide into the lane and closed willingly but a bit too late. ARGENTO'S FROST settled early, rallied four wide into the stretch and was gaining at the wire. TRICKY JOURNEY prompted the pace three wide into the stretch and weakened. FLAMMABILITY saved ground and closed a mild gap in the late stages. TORNADO MOUNTAIN settled early, then failed to respond while in the three path on the turn. FEARLESS FORCE broke slow but quickly rushed up to duel for the lead two wide to mid turn and came up empty for the drive. KING KAYIAN was never a factor.
