Footnotes

INCISIVE prompted the pace two wide from the outset, forged to the front once in the stretch, was head by HOT OPTION at the furlong pole but kept to his task and was back up late. HOT OPTION was never too far back racing inside MR DAY TRIPPER, waited for room behind the leaders near the quarter pole, swung out once in the stretch then offered his bid at the furlong pole but was outfinished. SOVIET TRICK lagged early, swung four wide while rallying on the turn then flattened out in the drive. COME ON DEPUTY settled early, saved ground and went evenly through the drive. MR. DAY TRIPPER tracked the pace three wide to the stretch and weakened. SUNDAE MOMENT set the pace from the inside to the head of the lane then had little left. ALWAYS FLIRTING saved ground to no avail.
