FLYING BISCUIT broke clean and dueled for the lead from between horses to the turn, got to the rail and responded to steady urging to the stretch then dug in gamely through a long drive and bested ARДУM ROSE. The latter dueled outside a three horse spread to the turn, raced two wide and took a narrow advantage mid turn, responded to steady pressure through a prolonged stretch run but just missed. TEAM DECISION broke a bit slow but hurried up to join the leaders inside to the turn, fell back to the stretch then angled out once in the lane and closed quickly in the final sixteenth. GO HONEY GO was settled to the turn, tried to rally three wide to the stretch but was outfinished late. TERESA BELLE was also allowed to settle, raced two wide to the stretch then lacked the needed late response. SLEW THE MONEY was not a factor.
