Footnotes

DESERT SEA took back at the start but was always within striking distance, commenced his bid four wide on the second turn, rallied into the lane to gain command at the furlong pole and drew clear driving. BARILOCHE tracked the dueling leaders from off the rail, swung three wide on the second turn and raced up to challenge at the quarter pole, dueled to mid stretch and slackened. SPEED ROUSER raced up three wide on the first turn and challenged MOMOTOMBO nearing the half mile pole, dueled into the stretch and slackened. RECKLESS WIND settled close up early from the rail, got through inside MOMOTOMBO leaving the half mile pole to challenge for the lead but gave way at the furlong pole. CLIFF DWELLER lagged early, came three wide to the stretch but lacked the needed response. MOMOTOMBO bobbed at the start but quickly recovered and set the pace from off the rail, was headed at the half mile pole and gave way between horses into the second turn.
