NURSE STEPHANIE broke a bit slow then checked briefly while crossing on to the main track, made the lead in the opening quarter and set all of the pace, drifted inward slightly in the upper stretch, was straightened then drifted in again nearing the sixteenth pole, all the while holding a slim edge to win driving. MISS NIKKI J prompted the winner two wide throughout and was gaining late. GO FORMAL settled early, was in the two path on the turn and closed a gap late. AWESOME PLAN stalked the pace three wide throughout and made a late gain. RUMINATE raced unhurried early, was four wide on the turn but lacked the needed rally. BEEZAROO stalked the pace from the inside into the stretch, but lacked a clear path on the rail in the upper stretch, when room developed nearing the furlong pole went for the opening inside NURSE STEPHANIE but was forced to steady hard at the sixteenth pole as the hole closed again, then fell from contention. KELLI'S COMET was outrun. The stewards posted the inquiry and disqualified NURSE STEPHANIE for interference in the stretch to BEEZAROO
