Footnotes

BEST VERSE raced up outside MEMPHIS MOBSTER on the first turn to prompt that rival for the lead, took command for good nearing the half mile pole, drew clear in the upper stretch and held driving. SPEED ROUSER settled early but was always within striking distance, saved ground on the second turn but eased out for the drive then could make little headway against the winner but gained second late. TWAIN'S TITAN tucked in behind the dueling leaders and tracked those rival to the second turn, eased outside the winner into the lane but lacked the needed response. RENZO SEAN stalked the pace three wide early, was caught four wide on the second turn and failed to respond. WARREN'S CONCEPT saved ground throughout and failed to rally. QUASICOBRA showed little. MEMPHIS MOBSTER set the pace from the inside for six furlongs, stopped into the lane and was eased through the drive but walked off.
