**Footnotes**

DIRECTOR'S CUT broke alertly and took the lead into the first turn to set all of the pace, was headed on the second turn by AERIAL STORM, shifted outside that rival and kept to his task to rally back to the lead while drifting out and was up late to win driving. MO STEAM lagged early, rallied four wide on the second turn and finished full of run. AERIAL STORM tracked the pace from the outside, took command two wide on the second turn, led to the deep stretch and weakened. PRINCE NOVETTI was void of early speed from the rail, came three wide on the second turn and rallied through traffic. JEHOVAH JIREH settled early three wide, raced four wide on the second turn but failed to rally. GEARING UP was forwardly placed from the outset, offered a bid four wide on the second turn but gave way. GLOBAL DESTINY saved ground to no avail. TAYLOR MOUNTAIN lacked early speed then was fanned five wide on the second turn and did not respond. ASNAAN was well placed from the outset, moved up three wide on the second turn but flattened out in the drive. SEEKING ROSES raced wide throughout and failed to reach serious contention. FAST AS POSSIBLE saved ground to no avail. BOLD MEETING became

fractious just as the gates opened, got caught in the gate and broke at least ten lengths last then was never close. the stewards posted the inquiry and determined that his gate opened properly and allowed the original finish to stand.
