STORM IN BLAIRSDEN set all the pace, turned back RED DANGER on the second turn, inched away to mid stretch then held determinedly. ELLO GUV settled inside to the second turn, remained inside and was asked for more speed to the stretch then finished willingly but was too late. MACHO BULL trailed to the backstretch, was widest to the second turn, came four wide to the stretch then finished steadily without being a serious menace. RED DANGER prompted the pace to the five eighths, moved up alongside the winner and vied for the lead to the quarter pole, could not push in front of STORM IN BLAIRSDEN and was outkicked to mid stretch then finished evenly. EL MARIACHI tracked the leaders three wide to the stretch then could not muster the needed late response. BENCH LIGHT chased the pace for five furlongs, tried to rally while between rivals and two wide to the stretch but came up empty in the final furlong.
