Footnotes

MOVE OVER MARINO raced up in the opening stages to take a narrow lead in the opening quarter, continued to set the pace under heavy pressure to the furlong pole then gradually proved best. SIBERIAN COCKTAIL prompted the winner two wide throughout and weakened leaving the furlong pole but held well for the place. SECRET JACKPOT took a few stride before taking hold then rushed up from the rail to stalk the pace, continued to be a factor into and through the drive but lacked the needed response. ROYAL SHRINE was forwardly placed from the outside, came four wide to the stretch but went evenly through the lane. HE DID was well placed, had his best bid three wide into the stretch but could not sustain it. PREMIER DIABLO raced unhurried early, was just off the rail on the turn and closed only a very minor gap. STAND TALL settled early from the outside, remained four wide on the turn and never reached serious contention. PATS PRIDE had no speed.
