COMPANY MEETING broke alertly but was permitted to slip back from the inside but always remained easy striking distance, commenced his bid two wide on the second turn, rallied into the lane, took command in mid stretch and held driving. MAN OVERBOARD lagged early from off the rail, remained in the two path on the second turn, shifted out into the lane to quickly rally, got to terms with the winner a furlong out but could not quite match strides. BLUEGRASS CHAPP dueled outside FOLLOW THROUGH to mid stretch and slackened. GENERAL CAUSEWAY was unhurried early while three wide to the backstretch, remained out on the second turn to be fanned four wide into the stretch but lacked a closing response. FOLLOW THROUGH gained command early and slipped to the rail to set the pace under pressure, alternated with FOLLOW THROUGH to mid stretch and faltered. DOCTOR PARK stalked the pace to the second turn and gave way from the four path. SAROS SECRET was never a factor.
