PIANO KITTY chased the leaders to the turn, raced three wide to the stretch then rallied to the front in mid stretch and dug in gamely to prevail. FIFIE'S FANTASY was outsprinted early, bid two wide to the stretch, rallied to loom boldly in mid stretch then was outkicked by the winner. PERFECT CURLS was hustled early and dueled outside of BAKERS BEACH to the stretch, could not stall the winner to mid stretch and weakened. LIFE'S A THRILL had no speed, was three then four wide to the stretch but closed with a belated rally. EASY GOES BY also had no speed, was three wide to the stretch then failed to muster the needed response. COVER STORY was outrun throughout. BAKERS BEACH vied for the lead from the rail to upper stretch then tired.
