DEMON WARLOCK was asked for early speed but could not keep up and tracked the leaders to the turn, offered a bid inside to the stretch, took over at the quarter pole then was under steady urging to the line. MR. GENOA had good speed, raced off the rail into the turn, drifted out into the stretch, carrying those outside him wide, responded in the lane and held the place. ALLWOOD contested the pace to the turn, was forced four wide into the stretch then finished evenly late. BRIDGE BUILDER broke a step slow, had no speed and fell back to the turn, saved ground to the stretch then closed the gap to the line. SILVER DOLLAR DAY dueled for the lead from between horses to the turn, raced three wide then was shuffled back and checked at the quarter pole and weakened in the drive. A MEMO FOR AVIE dueled for the lead from the outside to the turn, was fanned five wide to the stretch and gave out.
