SEAMARK was unhurried for a half mile, rallied three wide on the second turn, pushed past HURRYHAWK to take over in mid stretch and drove clear. HURRYHANK set all the pace to the second turn, responded to the stretch, could not stall the winner but had enough of a cushion to save second. RED GLOBE was four wide to the backstretch, settled to the second turn, bid three wide to the stretch then failed to threaten in the drive. FLAMMABILITY was allowed to settle to the second turn, raced two wide to the stretch then did not rally. CURIOUS SPY tracked the pace to the second turn but had little to offer in the stretch. EXPENSIVE JET pressed the pace to the second turn, stopped after six furlongs then was eased in the stretch but walked off.
