TUXEDO JUNCTION was void of any early speed, continued to trail entering the stretch but unleashed a bold rally once straightened for the drive, split CARRIE CAN and FLEETING DREAMS in midstretch, took command late and drew clear driving. FLEETING IMAGE settled just off the pace, advanced three wide on the turn, loomed a bold factor in midstretch but could not hold the winner. AUGUST QUEEN lacked early speed from the outside, remained five wide on the turn and finished willingly. HOT LEAR settled early, advanced inside AUGUST QUEEN on the turn and finished well without being a serious late factor. THERESA'S TIZZY settled inside early, advanced two wide on the turn, loomed a factor in the upper stretch then flattened out, bumping with HOUR STAR late. CARRIE CAN was unhurried early, came three wide on the turn, loomed a factor in the upper stretch but lost her punch. HOUR STAR sprinted clear early under a snug hold, maintained her edge into the lane then gave out, bumping with THERESA'S TIZZY late. FINITE E. F. settled between horses early, improved her position into the stretch then gave out. NEBULAR stalked the pace from the inside and stopped. FOLKLORE pulled up and was vanned off.
