TERRELLA broke alertly and raced just off the pace, advanced three wide into the stretch, forged to the front at the furlong pole and lasted. THURLOW was void of early speed despite urging, was fanned six wide into the stretch then closed willingly to just miss getting up. A. P. ANNA was well placed early, raced in the four path on the turn and was gaining late. BWANADADA raced close up early, was two wide and between horses on the turn but had only a mild finish. DEVOTED TO SHARK sprinted clear early to set all of he pace to the furlong pole and gave out. WOO lacked early speed then failed to respond while five wide on the turn. ELIZABETHAN ROSE saved ground to no avail. RAMONA'S RIDE showed little. FLASH AND CLASS had no speed.
