SIR AL (IRE) broke alertly and took up a good position from the inside and raced unhurried to the second turn, gradually eased three wide to enter the stretch, rallied steadily and was up in the final strides. TITIAN dueled from the inside, disposed of SEE ZO GO entering the stretch to take a clear lead but could not quite stall the winner. CODY PEAK raced unhurried early while three wide to the backstretch, saved some ground on the second turn while rallying to contention, loomed a bold factor a furlong out then lacked a late response. SEE ZO GO prompted the pace two wide for six furlongs and weakened. ROYAL IMPORT (GB) saved ground to no avail. CLASSICAL BARTOK tracked early two wide then failed to respond from the four path on the second turn. SPEED ROUSER tracked the pace three wide to the second turn, drifted to the five path on the turn and gave out.
