LAST DRAW had no speed, eased to the rail, saved ground to the stretch, rallied under vigorous handling in the drive and was along in time. PARTY AT MY PLACE chased the pace to the turn, was asked three then four wide to the stretch, rallied in the drive but was outkicked by the winner. SUCCESSFUL BLUFF set the pace to the stretch, responded to mid stretch but was tiring in the late stages. SUPERCABRAS had no speed, was fanned out four wide to the stretch then finished willingly late. SOUND OF MONEY got outsprinted to the turn, raced two wide to the stretch, rallied to mid stretch then weakened. MTN RANCH WILLY prompted the pace two wide to the stretch then gave way. TUDOR BLUE was a pace factor early, saved ground to the stretch then also was tiring late. WILLYCAN chased the leader to the turn, came three wide to the stretch but weakened in the drive.
