OLYMPIC GOLDDIGGER was well placed to the second turn, rallied three wide to the stretch, took the lead a furlong out then dug in late to hold. MR. REABURN never far back to the second turn, bid two wide to the stretch, responded to deep stretch but hung in the final yards. BIRD COLONEL settled mid pack for a half, commenced a bid three wide on the second turn, loomed to deep stretch then was outfinished. TRIBUNAL BLUES was allowed to settle to the second turn, saved ground to the stretch then lacked the needed response. ACCOMODATOR prompted the pace to the second turn, took a short lead to the stretch but tired through the drive. LOTA SPUNK broke a step slow then had no speed despite urging, was two then three wide to the stretch and gave way in the drive. FREEDOM BLUES had no speed and was not a factor. FIND THE ANSWER set the pace to the second turn then tired.
