GILLIGAN had no speed and trailed to the second turn, waited while two wide to the quarter pole, eased out for room into the stretch then responded to strong urging and surged late to get the nod. STORMY SURGE was allowed to settle for a half, bid inside on the second turn, rallied to take a clear lead leaving mid stretch then could not hold off the winner and was nailed. WESTERN ROSES chased the pace to the second turn, bid two wide to the stretch, dueled to mid stretch but was weakening in the late stages. DIAMOND TOUCH was outrun to the half, tried to rally three wide on the second turn but came up empty in the drive. CAPTURE THE CALL sped clear in the opening furlong, set all the pace for six furlongs but tired through the stretch.
