**Footnotes**

ELAINA'S PAPOU was unhurried to the half, bid three wide to the stretch, rallied to the front then drifted inward but was clear. BRITE JUDY steadied away from LANA LANG into the first turn, trailed for a half mile, also bid three wide on the second turn, could not impact the winner late but dug in to wrest the place from LANA LANG on the line. MISS RIVERA set the pace while three wide to the second turn, responded to pressure to mid stretch, was being outrun by the winner leaving mid stretch then the rider dropped his whip at the entrance to the chute and checked after the winner had gone by her. LANA LANG was rank and steadied into the first turn, stalked the pace for six furlongs, was outkicked to the stretch and weakened. AUTUMN FIRE chased the pace for a half, got fanned four wide on the second turn, stopped after six furlongs, was eased then walked off. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the stretch run but determined that no foul had occurred and no change was warranted.
