MUSIC APPEAL was unhurried to the half, saved ground on the second turn, steered out once straightened for the drive, responded to strong urging and surged in the final yards to be up in time. DIXICO stalked the pace to the second turn, bid two wide to the stretch, dueled TRICKY MANDATE through the final sixteenth then was tagged by the winner late. TRICKY MANDATE set all the pace from off the rail for five furlongs, lugged out leaving the quarter pole and was three wide into the stretch then responded to pressure, stayed on gamely to deep stretch but was bested in the final yards. SUMMER SUNTAN had no speed and settled to the second turn, was roused three wide, eased widest into the stretch and was making up ground belatedly. SKATTLE SEATTLE also stalked the pace to the second turn, offered his best try three wide to the stretch then flattened in the final furlong. BUCKSHOT BOB had no speed, settled for a half mile, raced two wide on the second turn but gave out in the drive.
